Creative Writing Competition – from Term 1


We had 19 entries in the competition. Congratulations to all that entered. It was a difficult decision - the following students were awarded prizes.






Riley's story titled 'The Sewerage Monster' was well written and also published into a book with illustrations. Here are images of his story for you to enjoy:
